Please submit your application at least **two months** before the beginning of the period you intend to spend at UFC, to give enough time for the procedure at UFC as well as for that of your visa application.

Information for international students (continued)

Language Courses are given in **Portuguese**. Although there is no formal

requirement, it is strongly recommended that foreign students

should be able to communicate in Portuguese.

UFC offers free courses of Portuguese, but it is advisable to acquire a

working knowledge before you come.

Health Care Foreign students are responsible to provide for their health

insurance.

Accomodation UFC does not provide accomodation for international students.
