Eligibility:

International undergraduate students studying medicine or related sciences (typically in their first 2-3 years of study). Participants must be at least 19 years old on the first day of the program, be proficient in English, and have a strong academic background.

Students can choose from one of 12 course packages, tailored to include diverse areas such as: clinical medicine and clinical research; occupational science and occupational therapy; pharmacology; radiology; anatomy; psychiatry; population and public health; physical therapy; laboratory science.
