General Information for International Students

Course Offerings

In principle, international students may be granted access to any and all courses, as long as they meet the necessary prerequisites and provided that there are no scheduling conflicts. However, the decision to accept international students falls solely on the coordinating office of each program, commensurate with their capacities. Language of Instruction

Portuguese is the main language of instruction at UFC. Portuguese as Foreign Language courses are available at no cost to applicants, but students should acquire a working knowledge prior to their arrival in Brazil.

General Application Requirements

Enrollment: all incoming mobility candidates, including Internship applicants, must be regularly enrolled at their home institution.

Language: Although there is no formal requirement, it is strongly recommended that international students be able to communicate in Portuguese proficiently.

Required Documents:

- Application Form (see link below)
- Academic Transcript
- Motivation Letter
- Letter of Recommendation signed by the coordinator of international affairs at the home institution
- A photocopy of the applicant's passport

Internships: the application procedure for internships (medical or otherwise) is largely similar to the general academic mobility procedure. However, a different <u>Application Form</u> must be submitted for Medical Internships. Additional information on such processes can be found on the link above as well. As with Academic Mobility in general, students must be properly enrolled at their home institution. These processes may take longer than those concerning regular exchange periods.

Visa requirements: all international students must hold Student Visas, which may be obtained at a Brazilian Consulate in their country of origin before entering Brazil, with the documentation provided by UFC. This also applies to internships, even if their estimated duration is shorter than the period covered by a tourist visa.

Healthcare: incoming students should make their own arrangements to acquire health insurance coverage.

Application Deadline	Students should submit their applications at least two months (not counting holidays) prior to the beginning of the period they intend to spend at UFC, so that there is enough time to ensure proper accomplishment of all relevant procedures in the University, as well as those regarding visa applications.
